ANALYSIS OF STUDENTS' FEED BACK 2015-16 BISWANATH COLLEGE, CHARIALI

1. Majority of the students (85.36%) agreed that 80% to 90% of the syllabus was covered in class. 14.64% students agreed that 70% to 80% of the syllabus was covered in classes.
2. Regarding teachers' preparation for classes, major percentage of students (84.5%) found it satisfactory. Another 15.5% found it thorough.
3. 87.3% students assessed teacher's ability to communicate as good another 12.7% termed it as effective.
4. Majority students (82.4%) agreed that the teachers encouraged students participation in the class, while another 17.6% were of the view that teacher sometimes encouraged student's participation.
5. 81.2% of the students agreed that the teachers were helpful in advising .Another 18.8% found them sometimes helpful.
6. Regarding internal assessment, majority of the students (82.12%) found it regular. Another 17.88% found it fair.
7. 89.87% students thought that internal assessment would help them on their course grade to improve. Another 10.13% were uncertain about it.
8. 79.73% students commented that the teacher provided feedback on their performance with helpful comments.
9. Majority of the students (82.74%) agreed that there was opportunity for personal interaction with teachers. Rests commented that there was to some extent opportunity for personal interaction.
10. Majority of the students found the relationship with Administration, Library and Lib. Bearer as good (Administration 87.79%, Lib 66.73%, Lab 79.53%). Others found the relationship as average.
11. Regarding primary facilities in the college, student's views are different. 70.24% students marked drinking water facility as good. 29.76% marked it as average.
12. 86.30% marked classroom facility as good, 13.70% marked it as average.
13. 79.54% students marked toilet facility as good. 20.46% marked it as average.
14. 70.28% marked sports as good, 29.72 % marked it as average.



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15. Regarding common room facilities 80.52% marked it as good. 19.48% marked it as average.

16. 71.62% found Canteen facility as good. Rests found it average.

17. Most of the students offered suggestions to improve the library infrastructure and also suggested to set up one more reading room in the library.



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STUDENTS' FEED BACK 2016-2017 BISWANATH COLLEGE, CHARIALI

1. Majority of the students (85%) agreed that 80% to 90% of the syllabus was covered in class. 15% student agreed that 70% to 80% of the syllabus was covered in classes.
2. Regarding teachers' preparation for classes, major percentage of students (80%) found it satisfactory. Another 20% found it thorough.
3. 80% students assessed teacher's ability to communicate as satisfactory another 20% termed it as effective.
4. Majority students (84.10%) agreed that the teachers encouraged students participation in the class, while another 15.90% were of the view that teacher sometimes encouraged student's participation.
5. 76.23% of the students agreed that the teachers were helpful in advising .Another 24.77% found them sometimes helpful.
6. Regarding internal assessment, majority of the students (78.17%) found it regular. Another 21.83% found it fair.
7. 84.71% students thought that internal assessment would help them on their course grade to improve. Rest were uncertain about it.
8. 74.24% students commented that the teacher provided feedback on their performance with helpful comments.
9. Majority of the students (75.46%) agreed that there was opportunity for personal interaction with teachers. 74.54% commented that there was to some extent opportunity for personal interaction.
10. Majority of the students found the relationship with Administration, Library and Lib. Bearer as good (Administration 70.78%, Lib 71.74%, Lab 77.55%). Rests found the relationship as average.
11. Regarding primary facilities in the college, student's views are different. 64.26% students marked drinking water facility as good. Others marked it as average.



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12. 81.26% marked classroom facility as good, 19.74% marked it as average.

13. 71.44% students marked toilet facility as good. Rests regarded it as average.

14. Regarding common room facilities 74.58% marked it as good. 23.42% marked it as average.

15. 55.5% found Canteen facility as good. 45.5% found it average. 12. Most of the students suggested that smart class room facilities should be improved.



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STUDENTS' FEED BACK 2017-2018 BISWANATH COLLEGE, CHARIALI

1. Majority of the students (86.47%) agreed that 80 to 90% of the syllabus was covered in class.13.53% student agreed that 70% to 80% of the syllabus was covered in UG classes.
2. Regarding teachers' preparation for classes, major percentage of students (67.46%) found it satisfactory. Rest of the students found it thorough.
3. 69.11% assessed teachers' ability to communicate as satisfactory another 30.89% termed it as effective.
4. 77.15% students agreed that the teachers encouraged students participation in the class, while another 22.85% were of the view that teacher sometimes encouraged student's participation.
5. 68.29% of the students agreed that the teachers were helpful in advising .Another 31.71% found them sometimes helpful.
6. Regarding internal assessment, majority of the students (55.20%) found it regular. Another 30.31% found it fair.
7. 87.73% students thought that internal assessment would help them on their course grade to improve. Another 12.27% were uncertain about it.
8. 76.76% students commented that the teacher provided feedback on their performance with helpful comments.
9. Majority of the students (68.49%) agreed that there was opportunity for personal interaction with teachers.31.51% commented that there was to some extent opportunity for personal interaction.
10. Majority of the students found the relationship with Administration, Library and Lib. Bearer as good (Administration 66.80%, Lib 66.76%, Lab 59.57%).rest of the students found the relationship as average.
11. Regarding primary facilities in the college, students' views are different. 65.28% students marked drinking water facility as good34.72% marked it as poor.



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12. 76.38% marked classroom facility as good, 23.62% marked it as average.
13. 79.46% students marked toilet facility as good and others regarded it as average.
14. Regarding common room facilities 67.59% marked it as good. 32.41% marked it as average.
15. 48.8% found Canteen facility as good. 51.2% found it average.
16. Most of the students suggested making the wi-fi facility available in the College campus.

The result of Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is summarized as below:



- Total 402 responses are obtained from the students of UG and PG level programmes.
- 43 % male and 57% female students participated in this Survey.
- The students from M.A./B.A./B.Com./ B.Sc., involved in the survey.
- Average Student Satisfaction Index: 89.5 %




How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




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How well were the teachers able to communicate?













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






